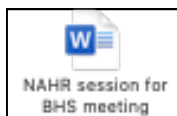
2 Minutes of the previous meeting



Action Points from last meeting

- **Amplitude Update meeting 23rd April 1230 – will need someone to attend – T Andrade and C McBryde will also attend – invites sent**
- **CMB and AJM to agree on a set of questions and send them to other Registry Leads in TORUS – Probably not required due to change in strategy for TORUS**
- **Cumberlege report - TA and AJM will frame a letter and send to various companies with the Cumberlege report. - Done**
- **NAHR session at BHS 2021 - Actioned**
- **Covid surveillance audit – direct contact by medical student - AJM to ask Julia Trusler whether this is acceptable from governance perspective; Email reminder to be sent regardless. AJM will ask amplitude. - Done**

3 NAHR session for BHS 2021



Discussed – slight change in plan to ensure greater involvement of US faculty who would now present the case followed by demonstrating a video of what was done. Sion G Jones cannot attend – CMB will replace
AP - AM to email faculty with change of plan.

- 4 NAHR MDS form** – consenting for contact (telephone to be added), addition of capsular repair/ type of chondral graft, addition of injection option – **AP – MB working to incorporate the changes**
- 5 Covid surveillance audit – Paper written. AP - AM to circulate**
- 6 NAHR restructuring**
Vice Chairman, Treasurer, Research lead, Compliance lead, Editorial secretary and Website lead – roles to be allocated in time when the team expands
- Regional representative (10) – Five applications – J Hutt, S Madan, Ashwin Kulkarni, Peter Wall, Owen Diamond. Some discussion about eligibility – in the past the aim was to get people in who have been contributing actively to the registry. For the new people may be difficult so it was proposed that they should be asked to submit data for 6 months. Other names proposed and discussed. To get into the NAHR board minimum two years of data contribution.
AP – AM to circulate a list of the numbers contributed by each applicant and perhaps approach other surgeons who would add value. The committee made some suggestions with regards names
- 7 NAHR Webinars (VK) – BHS – four sessions – Wednesday – Proposal –**
1. Independent webinars – How to use NAHR (MB)
2. National MDT/ complex case discussion – Four times a year
NAHS webinars already in place. Role of additional webinars discussed including having a national MDT of difficult cases. Most felt that there may be too much work involved and perhaps wait for expansion of the team.
- 8 Finances (TA) 43,692**
TA mentioned the problems with funding. S&N are continuing to support; Stryker want further information which will be provided to them (TA and AM to discuss); NTL Biological will also support – a letter has been already sent
- 9 Research update (AJM) -**
Provision of unpaid research fellows discussed – **AP will be discussed further in the BHS Exec before formal advertisement**
- AJM updated team with regards Pfizer’s proposal of using NAHR to do a study on injectable solution for OA. Before proceeding they wish NAHR to conduct a feasibility study on standard injection to assess the possibility of setting up a larger trial. They would be happy to support this and mentioned 10K as a possibility to help with the feasibility study. No sum was agreed and AJM had informed the Pfizer team of the efforts required to set this up and that it will be discussed in the Exec meeting. Team felt that a better understanding is required and a further meeting with Pfizer may be needed – **AJM to set it up**

VK proposed two studies – one on satisfaction after hip preservation surgery and another on the use of AI to predict outcomes. CMB wanted to understand the process of research proposals and informed of the Data request form that has been in existence. **AP – VK will get the necessary forms completed and submit**

Feasibility study on use of Chondral grafting also mentioned – TA and AJM have previously discussed this. **Meetings to be held with NTL Biologica and Arnika in this regard.**
